1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 19th day of March, 1990 at 8:00 P.M. in the Municipal Safety Building with the following members present:

Mr. Nicholson moved to amend the agenda to include Resolution No. CR-23-90; seconded by Mr. Buckley.


