20. Mr. Norris discussed the meeting with Mr. Stark in Columbus, Mr. Thomas advised Columbus' contract offered to Grove City was nearly the same as one Mr. Mitchell read at the last Council meeting. Columbus

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is planning on a county wide basis for sewage disposal which includes Grove City.

21. Mr. Mitchell presented some figures regarding costs of addition to sewage plant, proposed incomes and expansion. Discussion followed regarding a new process (temporary) for disposing of sewage.

22. Mr. Brinkman moved to go along with expanding present plant site. Seconded by Mr. Wagner. Mr. Norris made the statement that sufficient information was not available to make an intelligent decision. A roll call vote was taken:

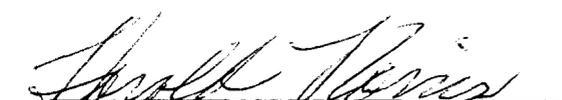
