

- 1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the twenty-first day of March, 1977 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers located in the Municipal Building with the following members present:

- 5. President Evans issued the Oath of Office to Mr. McDonald and seated him the second seat on his right. Mr. Kingsmore was seated on the President's immediate right.

- 6. Mr. Walter gave the report of the Safety Committee concerning the no parking restrictions on streets in the Brookgrove Subdivision.

He stated: These streets are 26 feet in width and the Mayor did have within the legal right to prohibit parking on both sides (According to the Ohio Revised Code) but after discussing it with the people concerned he arrived at the decision that one side prohibited would be sufficient.

Captain Hatfield, Jackson Township Fire Department, has assured Mr. Walter that the Fire Department has had previous difficulties in operating their vehicles on those narrow streets with parking on both sides.

This is not discrimination against people on those streets. The no parking program on one side of the street was instigated a year or so ago and is proceeding thought the city when funds become available to erect the signs.

A number of other streets in the city have had this ban for some time and the program will continue to be expanded.

Mr. Walter recommends that the Council take no action to rescind the Mayor's order.

A lady in the audience asked that if this no parking restriction will be enforced, would the city guarantee her that the snow plows would work both sides of the street.

Mr. Huber assured her that her street would not be denied services and would be plowed both ways if there were no cars parked on either side.

Joe Chesser asked that since these streets will be opened, would the 25 miles per hour speed limit be enforced.

Mr. Walter told him that this problem was discussed with the Chief of Police and he assured him that every action possible would be taken to control the speed in that area; that the Chief stated that if the vascar unit were set up on any given street that within 5 minutes every one in Grove City High School knows about it.

7. President Evans assigned tonights committees to Mr. Kingsmore, Finance; Zoning, Mrs. Myers; Safety, Mr. Walter; and Service, Mr. McDonald.
8. Council recessed to committees.
9. Council reconvened; called to order by President Evans.


