April 03, 2000

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Bennett, at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Mr. Eversman moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes for the previous meeting and approve as written; seconded by Mr. Radi.

3. Ordinance C-24-00 (Approve a PUD-I Zoning Classification for 5885 Haughn Road, upon its annexation to the City) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be held on May 15, 2000.

4. Resolution CR-23-00 (Approve the Final Development Plan for a Grandparents Residence, located at 4338 Haughn Road) was given its reading and public hearing.

Mr. Bruce Faris, architect representing petitioner, was present. Mr. Radi reviewed the stipulations and Mr. Faris agreed to all of them.

1. Ordinance C-21-00 (Appropriate \$14,000.00 from the General Fund for the Current Expense of the Installation of Entry Door Equipment) was given its second reading and public hearing.

Mr. Eversman explained that this is for both the Safety Building and City Hall. It will bring us into compliance with ADA requirements.

**There being no new business, the Chair recognized members of Administration and Council for closing comments.**

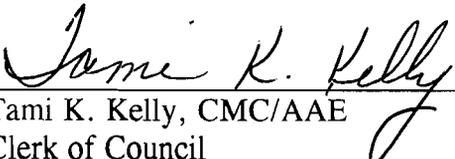
1. Mayor Grossman submitted the Mayor's Monthly Report and President Bennett moved to accept same; seconded by Mr. Eversman.
