COUNCIL MINUTES

April 19, 2004

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by Clerk of Council Kelly at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Ms. Kelly opened the floor for nominations of a Temporary Chairman. Mr. Hatley nominated Mr. Radi.
2. There being no further nominations, the floor was closed and Mr. Hatley moved that Mr. Radi be appointed as Temporary Chair; seconded by Mr. Lester.

3. Temporary Chairman Radi recognized the Mayor who administered the Oath of Office to Joe Wise as Captain and Steve Robinette as Lieutenant. She then read a Proclamation for Arbor Week and presented it to the Tree Commission. Urban Forester, Dan Snyder, listed the events and plantings for this week-long celebration.
4. Temporary Chairman Radi recognized Mr. Mike Rankin of the Mid Ohio Amber Alert Program, who provided an update and informational material. This program is an alert system for missing/abducted children, State-wide. He explained that when this program was set up, the Board developed a protocol for officers to follow when putting out an alter. However, by the time there is a need to use the system, the officers may have forgotten their training. So, the Board for MOAA is considering an initiative to develop a web based Amber Alert Investigation/Activation System. This would allow an officer to input data directly into a system, from the scene, that could be sent out immediately to other jurisdictions and the media. It could scan a picture of the victim and lessen the time and paperwork (8 forms) for the officers. The Ohio Attorney General's office is involved and assisting with this initiative.
