May 2, 1977

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the second day of May, 1977 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers located in the Municipal Building with the following members present:

Approximately 50 persons were in the audience supporting Mrs. Plymale. Speaking to Council about this matter were: Rev. Paul Taylor, Jean Kidwell, Robert Amos, Rev. Joe Rock, Pastor M.E. Nelson, Mrs. Gillogley and Mr. James Gillogley.

Ronald Plymale, City attorney and Director of Law, was absent from the meeting, but the Mayor and the Council stated that they would support any legislation that he would recommend to control the display and sale of pornography within the city.

He also announced that Grove City has entered a law suit against Columbus, the Ohio EPA and the US EPA for equitable sewer rates for all users of the Columbus lines.


