

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
May 5, 1958



Item:

1. Meeting called to order. On roll call all Council Members being present except Mr. Windsor. Rev. Proehl delivered Prayer.
2. Reading the minutes of previous meetings Apr. 7 and 21, were approved on motion by Mr. Harrington, 2 Mr. Haughn, all voting yea.
3. Mr. Cantor, Chairman of Planning Commission, gave a confirming approval for Richard Clark Multiple Units on Gladman Ave. & Columbus St. and a roll call vote resulted as follows: For - Hinton, Haines, Haughn. Against - Kiehl, Harrington. Absent - Windsor.
4. Hearing from Mr. Brownfield on rezoning Barfield Heights Subdivision, requested that he prepare matter in report for each member of Council.
5. First reading was given to following proposed Ordinances:
 - Consent to Highway Dept. to Plowing Snow and Ice Control on Broadway.
 - Establishing method to enter plea and confession in traffic violations in Mayors Court.
6. Roll call vote was taken with all members voting yea directing Engineer to prepare plans for improving Sewer Plant under adopted Plan 4.
7. On motion by Harrington, 2nd by Haines, it was directed that the Service Contract of City of Columbus covering Water be turned over to Board of Public Affairs. All voting yea.
8. Planning Commission submitted plan from Security Built Homes, Inc. for permission to construct Carport 5 ft. off lot lines in the following lots: 2, 4 and 6 in Block 8, and lot 16 in Block 7. On motion by Haines, 2nd by Harrington that same be approved and incerted in abstract of property. All members voted yea.
9. On motion by Mr. Kiehl, 2nd Mr. Harrington, that the Engineer prepare revised assessments on Haughn Rd. Sewer line preparatory to issuing Bonds and Certifying assessments to County Auditors Office. All members voting yea.
10. Solicitor to check Building Code to advise Council for authority to demolish old buildings.
11. Motion by Haines, 2nd Haughn, that Service Committee advertise for bids to cover contract for hauling Garbage. All members voting yea.
12. Discussion of Concrete base streets in open form with no action.
13. Discussion on owners or operators of Motor Vehicles parking cars and leaving keys in cars. Results: Instructing Solicitor to prepare Ordinance of Traffic Violation in such acts.

14. On motion awarding contract for laying Blacktop on streets by Mr. Hinton, 2nd by Haines, same was awarded to Robt. J. Dienst and Son @ 15¢ per yd., all members voting yea. The only other bid was Max Zeller, Inc. @ 17¢ per yd.
15. Permission was granted to FFA to hold a fish fry on May 24th.
16. On motion by Mr. Haines, 2nd by Hinton, no double parking shall be permitted in the business section at any time where there is rear access to said property and in the event no rear access then only 10 minutes time allowed for any double parking for commercial vehicles only.
17. A roll call taken of members produced no further business.
18. No second readings.
19. No third readings.


On a motion by Mr. Hinton, 2nd by Haughn, that all bills be approved for payment, all members voting yea.
