5 The Clerk read the following correspondence:

- a. Letter from Columbia Gas of Ohio advising that as of June 1 the service rates will be decreased an additional 2.31 cents.
- b. Two requests from Ohio Department of Liquor Control requesting approval or disapproval of a C2 permit for Freemans Carry Out and a D5 license for Holiday Inn. There were no objections.
- c. A letter from Mayor George Haughn vetoing Ordinance C-56-67 which reads as follows:

It is with regret that I must veto Ordinance No. C-56-67, but there are factors which I feel compelled to call to the attention of our City Council which, I feel, necessitate this veto.

I think it is agreed that there will be a need for a major shopping center in the Grove City area and that the population of this area, at some future time, can justify this. Because, however, there is likely to be only one such major shopping center, we should exert every effort to assure that its location, size and character will be that which is most advantageous to the Grove City community.
