1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the sixth day of May, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

  8. Speaking to Resolution CR-15-85, Mr. DeWeese stated his objections to this resolution and to the way this matter was handled.




18. Ordinance No. C-34-85 (Pay scale for clerical employees) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on May 20.
