MINUTES

May 12, 1980

Special Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in special session on May 12, 1980 at 6:30 p.m. in the council chambers with all members present. Also attending the meeting were: Mayor Evans, Charles Boso, R.E. Gunderman and reporters from the Record and Dispatch.
2. Mayor Evans gave the council a report on damage to buildings and automobiles in the city during the hail storm on Sunday, May 11. He stated that the damage would be as much as \$30,000,000. He stated that the Mayor's from other suburbs in the county have offered assistance in the line of equipment or manpower to help the city clean up the debris. However, he said that our city crews have most of the problems under control.

Mayor Evans suggested that the people who have damage deal with a reputable firm for repairs.


Mayor Evans will contact the Franklin County Disaster Control to see if the city can be declared a disaster area and be eligible for low-interest loans for repairs for those without insurance or large deductible policies.


It was suggested that there be made a hot-line to the building department for information on a reasonable range of costs for repairs and suggestions as to who does repairs of various types like roofing, glass, cars, etc.
