MINUTES

May 14, 1984

Special Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in informal session at 7:30 p.m. on May 14, 1984 in the Council Chambers with the following members present:

2. Larry Schaeffer, Attorney for the Farmers Exchange and Kent Ozmun, attorney for the prospective buyer of the Town and Country building on S. Broadway told council of the sewer line that runs under the Town and Country building; that the prospective buyer cannot get financing until the sewer is relocated; that the Farmers Exchange is willing to share one half of the costs of relocating the sewer.

Mr. Dickhaus gave a cost estimate on the relocation; the route of the new line and easements for it that would have to be obtained.

The council and the administration expressed that they would agree to some cost sharing but not one half of the expected costs.

The council agreed to have a resolution submitted for action that would state the council's intention of having this line moved and assume a portion of the costs.

3. It was agreed that Resolution CR-8-84 (COTA plans) that was postponed on April 2 until June 4 would be brought before council for action on May 21.
4. Other items discussed were: The narrow lot on the southeast corner of Kingston Ave. and Broadway; Improvements to Kingston Avenue, Haughn Road and Hoover Road; Park employees salary; an agreement with the Grove City Development Company for new developers to reimburse the company for improvements to Sonora Drive; and the purpose and use of the tax budget that is submitted to the Franklin County Budget Commission each July.
