MINUTES

May 16, 1977

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the sixteenth day of May, 1977 in the council chambers located in the Municipal Building.

2. Dr. Carl Wiley gave the invocation and roll was called and the following members were present:

9. Dr. Carl Wiley, representing the Sothwest Suburban Ministerial Association read a statement to Council supporting the enforcement of the Code (Sec. 533.12) dealing with pornography and obscenity. Also speaking against the display and sale of pornography were Mrs. Don Kidwell, Rev. Bruce Harrison and Bruce Price.

10. Bruce Price and Robert Griesenbrock spoke to Council about the site plan and other plans of the Ohio State Trap Shooters Association to locate on Route #62 south of Grove City near Beatty Road.

41. Mayor Brandt also announced that he had an appointment with Mayor Moody of Columbus on Tuesday at 3:30 to discuss the Sewer rates.


42. Mr. Bischoff stated the plans for the Patzer Avenue Storm Sewer were complete and expected to bid the job in June.


