1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the seventeenth day of May, 1976 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers located in the Municipal Building, 42 East Park Street with the following members present:

Mr. McDonald announced receiving a letter from the Columbia Gas of Ohio that due to the enactment of Amended Substitute House Bill Number 1213 by the Ohio Legislature requiring that gas utilities cease including the cost of special emergency gas purchases to non-curtailed customers and that the previously announced Purchased Gas Cost Adjustment will be reduced by 4.83¢ per one thousand cubic feet effective with bills rendered on and after April 28, 1976.
5. Council recessed to committees.
6. Kay Hennis, Dave Gusa, Gary Hennis and Dallas Evans, all of Hoover Road addresses, spoke to council and the administration about the address changes in their area of town. There followed a lengthy discussion on the need and reasons for these changes.

19. Mayor Brandt announced that Grove City now has a full-time Deputy Registrar at Culp Heating and has the cameras for drivers licenses.


