

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING

May 18, 1959

Item:

1. Meeting opened by Prayer given by Rev. Griffith. All members of Council being present.
2. Minutes read of previous meeting. On motion to approve by Haughn, 2nd Harrington, all voted yea.
- Extra. Mr. Hickman representative of Hubman Supply presented to Council the matter of a Foging Machine and their Fog-o-cyd material. Same referred to committee for further study.
3. Planning Commission passed.
4. Gunderman matter passed.
5. Flood Water Study Group presented a report of their survey covering five point program.  
  
Then the matter was deferred for a special meeting to be held Friday, May 22 at 7:30 p.m.
6. In the matter of Park area on Columbus Street the Engineer was directed to make a survey of the area for the Park Board. Further on motion by Haughn, 2nd Harrington, to appropriate \$700.00 for use by the Park Board, a roll call vote was as follows: Yeas - Haughn, Hinton, Harrington, Kiehl, Rothwell, Brinkman. No Neas.
7. Under Zoning there were questions raised as to Business operations being carried on in residential areas. Mr. Haughn to furnish list to Mayor for investigation.
8. Solicitor reported receiving letter from Attorney for Ziner's offering to settle in full for ground and damages as to Disposal Plant the sum of \$25,000.00. On motion to postpone action until further study by Haughn, 2nd Hinton, all voted yea.
9. In the matter of Radar, same postponed until after June 6. Date set for Demonstration.
10. In the matter of Ord. 184. On motion to re-draft Ordinance with new enforcement section made by Hinton, 2nd Haughn, all voted yea.
11. In the matter of Building Inspector. Discussion was entered into as to seperate Electrical, Plumbing and Building Inspectors. The matter passed after no action taken.
12. In the matter of streets, a motion to prohibit left-hand turns from Broadway into Jackson Street made by Haughn, 2nd Harrington, all voted yea.
