MINUTES

May 18, 1987

Regular Meeting

---

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 18th day of May, 1987 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

2. The meeting opened with a moment of silence in remembrance of Paul White, former Mayor and Councilman, and Charles Pappas, who regularly attended the council meetings.
3. Jack Foulk, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, presented a county flag to Mayor Evans for the City. The flag was formally adopted by the County on April 30, 1987.
4. Mr. Stage read Resolution No. CR-25-87 (To Larry Finley, Officer of the Year) and moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. List. Motion carried. Mr. Stage presented the resolution to Officer Finley.
5. Mr. Cotton read Resolution No. CR-27-87 (To students participating in Student Government Day) and moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Nicholson. Motion Carried. Mr. Cotton presented the resolution to Mona Hopkins representing the students.
6. Mr. Stage moved to dispense the reading of the minutes; seconded by Mr. Nicholson.

7. Council recessed to committees.
8. During discussion of Ordinance C-38-87 (Gantz Park Barn), Mr. List stated that he would encourage cooperation between the Southwestern City School and the City Park Department to maximize the facilities of both so that they have the optimum use by not duplicating efforts and offering the same type of programs or classes.

Mr. Cotton asked about the lights in the park. Mr. Thomas stated that the lights Mr. Cotton was asking about were for night activities and not security lights.

Mr. Stage stated that in conjunction with the barn and as a part of this appropriation, the Gantz House is to be upgraded esthetically so that the city does not put this much money into the barn and have the house with boarded up windows. Mr. Stage asked Mr. Thomas for an overall plan for Gantz Park as to what is proposed in different areas of the park. Mr. Thomas had a color coded plan with him and

the council and other interested persons review it during recess.

9. Mr. Mountain stated that Resolution CR-37-87 (assessments for sewer line in Briarwood Subdivision) would be tabled. There are changes to be made in the Resolution and the changes will be made by the city's bonding counsel.

President Nicholson asked for a letter for the Church of the Nazarene stating that the resolution would be acted upon at the next meeting of Council.

10. Council reconvened.

11. President Nicholson read the following into the minutes:

To Whom it may concern: The Council of the City of Grove City wishes to state that it will proceed with the legislation necessary for bonding of the Mulberry Run Sanitary Sewer, south branch, project and will process the initial legislation at its next regular meeting on June 1, 1987. Signed by all five councilmen.


