May 19, 1958

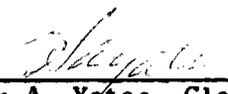

1. Meeting opened by prayer by Rev. Cooper of the Methodist Church. Roll Call with the following members present - Hinton, Haughn, Harrington, Haines, Kiehl and Windsor.
2. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved by all members voting yea.
- 2.A. On motion by Kiehl, 2nd Haines, approval was given Mr. Dale Wyker, Postmaster to set all letter boxes in concrete base.
3. On motion by Mr. Kiehl, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea to Renew Contract with Mr. Winfield for 1 year for removal of trash.
4. On motion by Mr. Harrington, 2nd Haines, that Renewal of Contract for Garbage removal with Pleas King be referred to Safety & Service Comm. for negotiation, all voting yea.
5. On motion by Haines, 2nd Kiehl, all members voting yea to defer Brownfield Shopping Center to next regular meeting for time to study same.
6. On motion by Haines, 2nd Hinton, all members voting yea, permission was granted Mr. Clark to public for two weeks notice of modifying Building Code to grant a variance to include the word apartments in said Code.
7. No Ordinances introduced.
8. No Resolutions introduced.
9. No matters before the body concerning Board of Public Affairs.
10. Recommendations from Planning Commission were, approval of construction of Medical Center by Dr. Henry and Rezoning area for construction of Kropp I.G.A. Store. On Medical Center Solicitor to prepare necessary legislation on motion by Haines, 2nd Hinton, all voting yea. On Rezoning Kropp area for Commercial Construction Solicitor to prepare proceedings for rezoning made on motion by Hinton, 2nd Windsor, all voting yea.
11. Engineer presented plans for sidewalk grade for Haughn Rd. and on motion by Kiehl, 2nd Harrington, Solicitor to draw up Legislation covering same, all members voting yea.

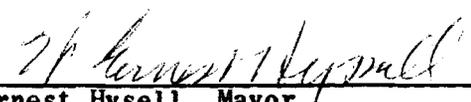
Mayor appointed assessing board Mr. Otto Galle, Mr. Ben Ahman and Mr. Jerry McGath to meet with Engineer for reappraisal and assessment on Haughn Rd. Water & Sewer Line assessments.

Report and letter from Water Pollution Board granting permit to operate Disposal Plant to January 19, 1959.

12. Mayor appointed committee composed of Mr. Haines, Harrington, & Haughn to inspect Lem's Swap Shop and barn on Schook Property for purpose of demolition of same and make their report.
13. A final report was given by Chairman Harris on the streets improvement of Blacktop laying and the total expenditures of \$12,491.00. He was given a vote of thanks on the fine work accomplished.
14. On motion by Haines, 2nd Hinton, all members voting yea, Permission was granted to Teenage Club to use the City Garage for their meeting place for a period of six months.
15. On motion by Kiehl, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea, Permission was granted to Street Dept. to employ part-time help @ the rate of \$1.50 per hour to be used at the discretion of the Mayor.
16. On motion by Kiehl, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea, Permission was granted to Police Dept. to employ extra help for vacation periods etc. at the discretion of the Mayor.
17. On roll call of Council the following items were offered;
- Motion to advertise for Contract for Gasoline, Oils, Tires and Batteries to be let on contract, by Hinton, 2nd Kiehl, all voting yea.
- Motion to pay bills, Hinton, 2nd Harrington, all voting yea.
- Motion to take Membership @ \$50.00 per year dues in Mayor's Council of Franklin County by Kiehl, 2nd Harrington, all voting yea.
18. Second reading of Ordinance 10-58 entering method plea in Traffic Court and Ordinance 11-58 consent to state for plowing snow and ice control on Broadway Street.
19. No third reading of Ordinances.
