May 19, 1986

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 19th day of May, 1986 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

Also speaking to the subject were Sandy Engleman, Woodlawn Avenue and John Orwitz, Southwest Boulevard.



6. John Orwitz, 2702 Southwest Boulevard, spoke to council requesting a reduced speed limit on Southwest Boulevard from Richard Avenue to Hoover Road and to install two three-way stop signs on S/W Blvd. to control the flow of traffic. President Nicholson turned this over to Safety Director Fulton.
7. Don Carey (not a resident of Grove City) spoke to Council objecting to a rezoning of Briarwood Hills #5 from R-2 to R-1.
8. Council reconvened.
9. Ordinance C-27-86 (Annex 0.345 Acres (Lot #17) of Castle Farm Subdivision) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on June 2.
10. Ordinance No. C-25-86 (Seat Belt Law) was given its second reading and public hearing and Mr. Stage moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Nicholson.
