1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the 20th day of May, 1974 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers located in the Municipal Building, 42 East Park Street, Grove City, Ohio with the following members present:

3. President Kingsmore read the agenda for the meeting.

5. Mr. McDonald expressed his opposition to the establishment of another charter revision committee (Res. CR-23-74). Mr. McDonald objected to changing Section 6.01 "Taxation & Borrowing". He stated that if this were changed there would be a possibility of additional real estate taxes. Mr. Kingsmore stated that there should be a study of the wards and a change made in the ward boundaries. That at the present time, about one-half of the population of the city is in one ward.
6. Mr. David Goodin, owner of the Lincoln Village Transit Company, spoke to council offering to give his Grove City route of bus service to COTA and have COTA serve this area. He stated that he is losing money on the Grove City Service and since the city is paying tax subsidy to COTA they should be making this service available to Grove City.
7. Mr. Kent Ozmun, attorney representing the property owners in the Park Ridge subdivisions, stated that 90% of the property owners had signed a petition for the city to have installed street lights with underground wiring and that they would pay the difference in the cost for this type of lighting.
8. Council reconvened; called to order by President Kingsmore.
9. Ordinance No. C-34-74 (Control lot grade) was given its second reading and public hearing.
