

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
June 2, 1958

Item:

1. Meeting opened by Prayer given by Rev. Bowsher.
Roll call with all members present, Hinton, Kiehl, Windsor, Haines, Harrington, Haughn and Mayor W. E. Hysell.
2. Reading of the minutes of previous meetings and on motion by Haughn, 2nd Haines, all voted yea. Minutes approved.
3. Report by Committee on contract with Pleas King on Garbage removal. Reported details on three years contract @ \$1.25 per month customer service charge. Referred same to Committee for further discussion.
4. On motion by Haines, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea, a fifteen minute parking regulation was granted in front of the Post Office.
5. On motion by Haines, 2nd Hinton, all members voting yea a "No Parking" order was approved for the period 5/30 to 9/1/58 to cover North side of Woodlawn from Arbutus to Dudley and to install four-way stop signs at Dudley & Woodlawn.
6. On motion by Haughn, 2nd Kiehl, all members voting yea, The Solicitor was ordered to draft Ton Limit Ordinance to regulate truck traffic weight control on certain streets of the City.
7. On motion by Haines, 2nd Haughn, Solicitor ordered to draw Ordinance for the purchase of used truck and compressor to be purchased for \$3,500.00. Roll call voted for Purchase - Hinton, Kiehl, Haines, Haughn. No - Windsor. Abstained - Harrington.

On motion by Haines, 2nd Haughn, to adopt Ordinance 12-58. Roll call vote yea - Hinton, Kiehl, Haines, Harrington, Haughn. No - Windsor.

On motion to suspend the rules calling for third readings of same and adopt said Ordinance 12-58 as an emergency measure, motion by Haines, 2nd Haughn, those voting yea - Hinton, Kiehl, Haines, Harrington, Haughn, and no - Windsor.
8. On motion by Hinton, 2nd Haughn, all members voting yea, that Solicitor draw advertisement for Public hearing to be held July 7th meeting for Rezoning Barfield Heights Commercial Section.
9. The first reading was given to the following Ordinances:

13-58 Accepting & approving Grade for sidewalks for Haughn Rd.


14-58 Authorizing membership in Mayor's Council of Franklin County, Ohio

11. On motion by Haughn, 2nd Haines, all members voting yea, that Ordinance be drawn by Solicitor to change the service charge for Sewer Taps from \$40.00 to \$100.00 per tap on recommendations from Board of Public Affairs.
12. No report from Planning Commission.
13. Engineer reported on costs for location of the Sewer Plant on Scioto River, Estimate Costs \$1,432,900.00.

Mayor read letter from Mr. L. J. Reimer that to locate said plant as reported, that it was/would be prohibitive to finance same.


Engineer further reported a drainage problem affecting Farmers Exchange et al and was ordered to present same to all parties concerned.

On Motion by Haines, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea, Ordinance 11-58 was approved to give Consent to the Highway to remove Snow and De-ice Broadway.
16. On Motion by Hinton, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea, approving all bills for payment.
17. There being no further business a motion for adjournment was offered by Hinton, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea.
