2. Reading of the minutes approved on motion by Haughn, 2nd Hinton, all voting yea.

4. First reading of Ordinance 15-58 providing for fee of \$100.00 for Sewer Tap. Motion to adopt said Ordinance 15-58 made by Haughn, 2nd Harrington, and on roll call, yeas - Hinton, Kiehl, Windsor, Haines, Harrington and Haughn.

Motion to suspend rule for third readings and make this third and final reading, yeas - Hinton, Kiehl, Windsor, Haughn, Harrington and Haines.

Motion to adopt rules for third & final reading on roll call, yeas - Hinton, Kiehl, Windsor, Haines, Harrington and Haughn.

First reading of Ordinance 17-58 Providing Penalty leaving keys in Parked Vehicle.

8. Engineers report. Beulah Park making correction in water drainage. Gave report on various plant sites for location of Disposal Plant.


On motion by Haines, 2nd by Hinton, all voting yea to revise plan No. 3 to move plant from present site to some location between Rt.#104 and present plant.

Further a motion by Harrington, 2nd by Haughn, all members voting yea, the Engineer and Solicitor were authorized to contact Mr. Henry Carlisle in reference to ascertaining price of land for Disposal Plant site on his land.



15. Motion that City charge the following fees for cutting weeds: \$15.00 per lot minimum and \$6.00 per hour for time in excess of 1 hour, made by Haines, 2nd Kiehl, all members voting yea.
