4. Brownfield not present same moved over to July 14.
5. Budget presented and moved over to July 14.
6. Bids received in compliance to advertisement on street repairs was submitted. No action. Solicitor to render opinion later.

Temporary No Parking approved for Kingston Ave. at Summers School.

The following streets were approved for sealing: Jackson, full length. Burr Oak. Grant Ave., from R.R. to Beulah Park. Park St., from R.R. to Elm. Midland, Curtis, Connor, full length. First Alley West of Broadway, between Grove City Rd. and Park St. Cleveland Ave. East, from Broadway to end. Dudley full length. Patzer Ave., from Park to Kingston. Wilbur Ave., full length. Haughn Rd. from Columbus St. to Park, and from Cleveland Ave. to Columbus St. the following - First St., Arbutus Ave. and Third St. Breck Ave.

Motion to readvertise by Kiehl, 2nd Rothwell, all voted yea.

7. Repair costs received for Gutter and Street for Robin and Woodlawn intersection. Hold matter until information is received concerning Kingston and Eleanor.

In matter of 3-M Co. same being taken care of by City Street Dept.

Motion to raise Grant Ave. Culvert by Haughn, and Engineer to get proposed costs, 2nd by Rothwell, all voted yea.

11. In the matter of Brown Run Engineer wanted to know if Council was going along on deepening Brown Run, and reported that Brownfield would agree to same sharing of costs.

12. Mr. Haughn reported that petitions had been submitted for Curbing East Side of Moore Ave. to Kingston, and further that the property owners on Grant Ave. wanted to put in Curbs.

18. Third reading Ord. 15-59 Requiring fencing Private Pools. On motion to adopt same by Haughn, 2nd Rothwell, all voted yea.


 Third reading Ord. 16-59 regulating Taxi Cab Service. On motion to adopt same by Hinton, 2nd Harrington, all voted yea.
