

**GROVE CITY, OHIO COUNCIL  
MINUTES**

July 06, 1993

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Brian Buzby at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

After a moment of silent prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called and the following members were present:

1. Mr. Buckley moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes and approve as written; seconded by Mr. Mountain.

**The Chair recognized Mr. Cotton, Chairman of Lands & Zoning, for discussion and voting of legislative agenda items under said committee.**

1. Ordinance C-58-93 (make amendments to Section 1135.10(g) of the Codified Ordinances) was given its second reading and public hearing and Mr. Buckley moved that this ordinance be tabled; seconded by Mr. Buzby.

2. Ordinance C-59-93 (Accept annexation of 6.642 acres located south of Grove City Road and west of Tanglebrook subdivision) was given its second reading and public hearing.

Speaking to this ordinance was Mr. Jamie Carey, 3852 Corona Ct. - He asked what the zoning for this property was going to be? Mr. Cotton informed him that this is the site for a proposed fire station by Jackson Township. Mr. Carey said he had concerns about the water drainage once this parcel was developed, especially if it were to be residential. Mayor Stage asked Mr. Blackburn (Service Director) if the Township will help the area that runs parallel to Demorest Road? Mr. Blackburn indicated that he was hopeful that a swale will be put in abutting those homes or some other improvement for that area. Mr. Boso stated that there is a development plan coming before Planning Commission on Tuesday, July 20, 1993 and one of the areas that will be looked at is the drainage.

There being no additional questions or comments, Mr. Cotton moved to approve C-59-93; seconded by Mr. Buckley.




**President Buzby asked that any New Business to be brought before Council, be done so at this time.**

**There being no new business, President Buzby recognized members of Administration and Council for closing comments.**

1. Mayor Stage acknowledged that the Police Department in conjunction with the Jackson Township Fire Department, completed Safety Town for all five year old's, free of charge. It is one of the best programs and he commended the Police and Fire Fighters. As far as July 4th Celebration, if we are just weighing fireworks, it was extremely successful. However, he feels the community needs more by way of a parade or Ice Cream Social and he will take on the responsibility of comprising an event for next year. The last item was the high water.. He said he drove around the City and said we were fortunate - we kept our electricity, the pumps still work, and there were no physical accidents. The amount of raid received in the short period of time we received it in is very hard to deal with and no lines could have handled it. He thanked the police and service department for their efforts.
2. Mr. Fulton announced that Chief McKean would be leaving on July 11, 1993 to attend the FBI Academy for 11 weeks. This is a great honor as very few get chosen to attend and commended Chief McKean. He announced that in Chief McKean's place, Captain Deskins would be taking over the day-to-day operations.
3. Mr. Ferguson asked Mr. Behlen for the cost of the Fire Station audit. Mr. Behlen stated that the information would be sent to him.
3. After comments from Administration, the Chamber and Council, Mr. Mountain made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Mr. Buckley. Motion carried.
