5. Mary Bordeaux, representing the Syntex Corp., spoke to Resolution CR-42-91. Ms. Wardell introduced Ross Webb and P.K. Kin, from Syntex, Architects Bob Apel and Larry Caldwell, Attorney Tom Mason, and a representative from their civil engineering office. Miss Wardell told the history of the Syntex Corporation, a pharmaceutical manufacture. Mr. Apel presented printed posters of the planned facility and a scale model of the interior and exterior of the building and the direction of future extension of the building.

It was stated this facility would be a distribution center for prescription prepackaged pharmaceuticals--no manufacturing on the premises or storage of chemicals; that it would be a one shift five day a week operation employing approximately 40 persons.

17. Mayor Stage gave the June report of the Building Department and Mr. Nicholson moved it be accepted; seconded by Mr. Buckley.


