Special Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in special session on the 31st day of July, 1989 at 7:30 P.M. in the Senior Center, Windsor Park, with the following members present:

2. Also attending were Mayor Stage and members of his administration and approximately 35 citizens of the city.
3. President Nicholson announced the meeting was called as a work session for discussion between the administration and council; that the meeting is not for public hearing of any subject discussed.
4. Item #1 for discussion was radio antennas. The Administration presented to the council proposed legislation, rules, regulations and guidelines comprised by Frank Elmer.

Kevin Kearns, attorney, stated the site selected by the applicant for a radio antenna tower is within the area approved by the F.C.C. regulations.

Further discussion concerned zoning, special use permits and other zoning district locations for antenna towers.


5. Item #2 for discussion concerned garbage and refuse collection, rates, disposal at landfill and trash burning power plant owned by the City of Columbus, recycling of materials and what the city can do to help ease the amount of trash and costs to the citizens.
6. Item #3 for discussion was a general sidewalk policy for the city. Legislation will be drafted and presented to Council.
7. Before adjournment, President Nicholson allowed brief remarks from the public.

Lonnie Alonzo, President of the Hawthorne Woods Homeowners Association, spoke in opposition to the proposed Borrer Road locations for a radio antenna.

Howard (Andy) Anderson spoke against a rate increase for refuse collection especially for retired persons.

Also speaking to council were Ted Fluhart and Harold DeWeese.

8. It was moved and seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.
