

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING

August 3, 1959

Item:

1. Mayor called meeting to order with all members of Council being present.
2. Reading of Minutes of July 20, 1959 and on motion to approve by Brinkman, 2nd by Harrington, all voted yea.
3. In the matter of drainage, on a motion that Street Supt. Harris proceed with rebuilding Grant Ave. Culvert as per plans submitted by Engineer, made by Haughn, 2nd by Brinkman, all voting yea.

Then the Engineer reported that Mr. Thomas reported for Evans Bros. that if Council would annex 16 acres and get water for all their acreage they would go along on Brown Run Project. They did not say, however, how much of the costs they would share.

On a motion by Rothwell, 2nd by Brinkman, all voting yea, it was ordered that Solicitor direct letters to Catholic Church, Parlin Sisters, Evans Bros., Glenn Lotz and Brownfield to appear before Council on August 14th so that definite information can be secured and plans for prorating costs necessary to Brown Run improvement.

4. The bid of Max Zeller, Inc. was submitted for sealing streets as follows: \$.18½ per Gal. material and sealing plus \$.09½ per Gal. transportation charge. Estimate was presented as to costs of Blacktoping Kingston Ave. Amt. \$3,474.00. No action taken. Mr. Haughn was to check further concerning sealing and blacktoping and report as to total costs covering same.

A Special Meeting was set for August 10.


On a motion to make First Street one-way from Civic Drive to Kingston Ave., made by Rothwell, 2nd Brinkman, all voted yea.
