1. Meeting opened by Mayor and roll call with all members present.
2. Motion by Haines, 2nd Harrington, all members voting yea approving minutes of July 21.
- 2A. Motion by Haines, 2nd Kiehl, all members voting yea to suspend reading Special Meeting minutes July 28.
3. In matter drainage Mr. Trego, Solicitor rendered decision not Village responsibility. Should revert to builder.

Motion by Haines to pay part of Mr. Trego costs. No second to motion. Same died for want of further support.

Motion to table same until next meeting by Windsor, 2nd Harrington, all voting yea.
4. Kropp rezoned plan referred back to Council by Planning Commission. Mr. Kropp amending same with restrictions. Mr. Myers, Attorney, representing first Petitioners opposing, says restrictions if placed in deeds will be binding.

Motion by Haines accepting amended request for zoning Kropp Commercial Plot, Seconded by Haines, voting as follows: Yea - Hinton, Haughn, Haines, Windsor. No - Harrington, Kiehl. Passed 4 to 2.
5. No report by Planning Commission.
6. Engineer reports Water situation Grant Ave., storm sewer to small. Recommending new Bridge at Grant Ave. & Curtis St. and ask County Commissioners for aid in drainage area. Discussion by residents in area. Remarks by Mr. Haines in reference to same.

Motion by Haines, 2nd by Haughn, that Solicitor prepare resolution requesting presentation of the matter of the County ditch Petition to County Commissioner.

Roll call vote, all members voting yea.
- 6A. La Rosa, Brookgrove, and Knapp Additions water situations discussed. City Engineer proposed a new 18 or 24" Sewer line parallel with present Haughn Rd. line from Columbus St. & Hoover Rd. to disposal Plant.

Engineer to report to next meeting on estimate costs and size of such line.

Drainage matter Farmers Exchange et al benefits that costs should be shared by Mr. White and Farmers Exchange. Mr. White refused. Engineer to investigate further. Moved by Windsor, 2nd Harrington, all voting yea.
- Water line installation on Haughn Rd. discussed. As to cutting off Roof Water tile lines by C. W. Pike Co., Engineer to investigate matter with Mr. Pike, also claim by Grant Wilt.

16. Communication from C.S.C, Inc, developers of Carbrock Addition, requesting payment balance \$780.89 their prorata share of Sanitary Sewer costs and on a motion by Windsor, 2nd Harrington, ordering same to be paid, all members voted yea.
17. Motion to pay bills by Haughn, 2nd Harrington, all voting yea.
- 10A. Engineer reporting on new Disposal Plant as discussed in meeting of Addition Council 8/1/58.
- Motion by Haughn, 2nd Haines, that present Plant be expanded for 11,000 Population.
