Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the fifth day of August, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

9. Kathy Wilkins, Townhouse Drive, asked the council for consideration of an ordinance to make smoke alarms mandatory in apartments.

10. Tom Wiley, Wendy Lane, asked Mr. DeWeese and the Safety Director to investigate speeding, junk cars and middle of the night drag racing at Wendy and Irwin.


