Special Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in special session with all members present. Also present were members of the Administration, the press and public.
2. President Weygandt called the meeting to order and stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss putting an income tax increase of 1% on the ballot for the November election.

Charles Boso discussed the anticipated amount the proposed increase would bring into the General Fund; what amounts could be specified for capital improvements or earmarked for other needs of the city.

Mayor Evans explained that the police contract was negotiated with the fact that the income tax increase would go on the ballot and be approved by the voters.

Mayor Evans stated that beside the raises for the police and other city employees, the city would have substantial increases in medical insurance and retirement systems in the next year.

3. It was agreed by the members of council and the administration that legislation should be presented at a special meeting on August 15 to initiate the question of a special election on November 8 for the purpose of increasing the city income tax from 1% to 2% and legislation authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge #9 for the years 1983, 1984 and through June 30, 1985.
4. President Weygandt announced the special meeting on August 15, 1983 at 8:00 p.m.
5. It was moved and seconded that council adjourn. Motion carried.
