1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the twelfth day of July, 1976 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers located in the Municipal Building, 42 East Park Street with the following members present:

2. Mr. Kingsmore moved that Council excuse Mr. McDonald; seconded by Mr. Walter.

8. The Clerk read correspondence from the Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. informing Council that the rates for gas would increase eight and twenty-eight hundredths cents per one thousand cubic feet effective with bills rendered on July 31, 1976.

9. Council recessed to committees to discuss the agenda.

10. Mr. Roland Edwards spoke to Council about Ord. C-64-76 that would accept 2.779 acres in West Grove #2 for park land in lieu of Development Fees.

11. Michael Hardesty and Mr. Walter Evans spoke to Council about the rezoning of 5.400 acres N. of Independence Street and S. of Home Road. They asked Council's consideration of waiving the thirty day waiting period if council approved the rezoning.

Mr. Don Wissman spoke to council as a neighbor to this rezoning. Mr. Wissman was particularly concerned that Independence Street would not become a through street to Home Road, Hoover Road or Broadway.

12. Mrs. Barbara Weygandt presented petitions with approximately 500 names to Council in opposition to a new sewer plant that the administration is considering in lieu of going to the Columbus or Regional Systems. Mrs. Weygandt was invited, along with all the people who signed the petitions, to attend the public meeting concerning the sewer system that will be held at Brookpark Middle School on July 13, 1976.

13. Council reconvened; called to order by Mr. Kingsmore.

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14. Resolution CR-19-76 was given a second reading. The attached Affirmative Action Program has been rewritten to specifications recommended by the Director of Law.
15. Mr. Walter moved that Resolution CR-19-76 be amended in the second line of Section 2 to read: "...hereby officially adopts the attached Affirmative Action Program." This was seconded by Mrs. Myers.

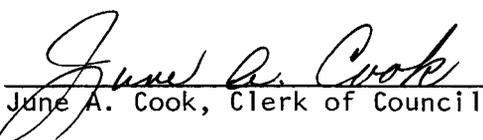
