

GROVE CITY, OHIO COUNCIL
MINUTES

September 2, 1980

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on Tuesday, September 2, 1980 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

2. Mr. Margello moved to dispense the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of August 11 and the special meeting of August 18; seconded by Mr. Dooley.

3. Council recessed to committees.

4. Speaking to Ordinance C-48-80 was Joe Leighty, accountant for Larry's trucking. It was decided by Council that this ordinance would be defeated and that the council needed further information and price documentation to justify the amount of money submitted for collection of storm debris.

5. Mr. Bill Myers, Health Commissioner for the City of Columbus spoke to Ordinance C-49-80. Mr. Myers stated that the services for the alcohol safety program were provided by the Norris Act; that the money was dispersed by the Ohio Department of Health from 1% of the sale of alcohol beverages in the state; that additional funds are needed because of the expansion of the program and the number of persons referred by the courts; that Columbus contributes from its general fund and some grants; that Upper Arlington has been asked to contribute and the health department has reasonable assurances that that city will; that the contribution from Upper Arlington and Grove City will pay for the services of one more counselor; that the fiscal year of the grant to the department is from July 1 to June 30.

This council decided to appropriate \$5,000 to the department for the balance of 1980 and would review the matter at the time of budget review in December.

6. On Ordinance C-55-80, the council is in favor of amending this ordinance to exclude Stringtown Road and to set the speed limit of 45 mph for Southwest Boulevard Extension only.
7. Robert Payne, Parlin Drive, Mrs. Saunders, Southwest Boulevard, Mark Linman, Additison Place and Mrs. Thompson, Richard Avenue spoke to council about backup water in basements and streets in the Parlin Manor-Regency Arms Apartments.
8. Peter Crane, Hoover Road, asked Council to consider the possibility of citizen volunteers to help build the police a shooting range (possibly on city property on Marlane Drive) if those citizens could at some odd times use that range when the police are not using it. It could be used to teach younger children the proper use of firearms and would give the people a place to shoot under safe and controlled conditions.

Mr. Margello stated that he is in favor of such a range but feels that it may need a committee to study liabilities, disturbance to the neighborhood; that he would like to be on a committee to study this.

9. Diane James, Magnolia Street, had written a letter to Mr. Margello about certain conditions of power outage, park programs and street lights in the Westgrove Subdivision and she spoke to council primarily about the problem of the lack of streetlights in the area.
10. Council reconvened; called to order by President Hampson.

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11. Resolution CR-24-80 (Plan for Harrisburg Station) was given its reading and Mr. Douglas moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Margello.




