September 2, 1986

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 2nd day of September, 1986 in the council chambers with the following members present:

3. President Nicholson introduced Florence Scarth, past member of the Township of Joby Council visting from Canada.

4. Mayor Evans introduced the Honorable Theodore Nicolay, Deputy Mayor of the City of Courbevoie, a part of metropolitan Paris, France. Mayor Evans presented Monsieur Nicolay a resolution proclaiming him an honorary citizen and honorary Deputy Mayor of the City of Grove City.

5. Council recessed to committees.

6. There was no pertinent discussion of the agenda items.

7. Larry Loretta, doing business as Looney Larry's Lounge on Broadway, spoke to council concerning their objections to his request for a D5 liquor permit from the State Department of Liquor Control. Mr. Nicholson stated that his objection, according to information from the Division of Police, that there were more police runs for types of situations that endanger the police officers at his place than all the other bars in town. Mr. Loretta stated that 80-90% of the calls were because he kept the back door open and the music was to loud and neighbors complained. Mr. Stage stated there were three police calls for a knife, six calls for fights, two domestic quarrles; that his concern was not only for the police officers but for the surrounding area. Chief Gabriel stated that the license that Mr. Loretta is using at the present time has two cocaine sales by the bartender pending.


