September 3, 1985

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the third day of September, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

Mayor Evans then introduced Glen Stoll and announced his promotion from Sergeant to Deputy Chief of Police and administered the Oath of Office to Major Stoll.
