1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Franklin County, Ohio met in regular session on the fourth day of September, 1973 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers located in the Municipal Building, 42 East Park Street, Grove City, Ohio with the following members present:

3. Clerk read correspondence from Roy, Grossman, President of the Grove City High School Band Boosters thanking council for their contributions to the Boosters to help defray the cost of a building permit.
4. Clerk informed council that she had received a letter from Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. informing the council that the gas rates would increase eighty-four hundredths of a cent per one thousand cubic feet effective on and after October 1 and an additional four and three hundredths cents per one thousand cubic feet effective on and after October 14. There followed a discussion about the Central Ohio Mayor's Councils progress in receiving a uniform gas rate for all communities. Mayor Brandt explained that several of the municipalities still have a contract with the gas company and that the PUCO would not hear a plea until all contracts are terminated. Grove City still has an existing agreement with the gas company and Mayor Brandt is hesitant about terminating this until he is positive that all the existing agreements would be terminated.
5. Council recess to committees.
6. Citizens who spoke to council concerning Ord. C-72-73 (Annexation) both pro and con were: Reobert Whittier, Robert Albert, attorney for Mr. Deffit, Rowland Stout, architect for Mr. Deffit, William C. McDonald, Mr. Hickman, Mark Jones and Max Gibboney.
7. During discussion of Ord. C-76-73 (To remove Charter Amendment from ballot), Mr. Ogg thanked the members of the Charter Revision Committee for their work and time.
 

Mr. Don Cotner spoke to council against this ordinance. As the chairman of a former Charter Revision Committee, he voiced his displeasure that the amendment would not be put on the ballot this year.
8. Mrs. Myers moves that the rules of council be suspended at this time to act upon Resolution No. CR-38-73 (To Mrs. Noltemeyer for the winning entry into the seal design contest). This was seconded by Mr. Ogg.
