1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in regular session on the sixth day of September, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

During discussion, Mayor Evans announced the establishment of the Grove City Foundation and the kickoff for funds will be on September 23 at Scioto Downs with a "Roast the Mayor" dinner and entertainment. The funds in the foundation will be used for the good of the community. The Mayor stated that this fund will be structured under the Columbus Foundation for management reasons. The monies will be set up in trusts in banks for no fees and will be in direct control of Grove City.
- There was discussion of Garage Sale signs starting to reappear on public property again and Mr. Gunderman stated that if a few people were prosecuted for this offense, the word would get around.
- Mr. Hampson asked Chief Gabriel to have his men police the city more for large trucks parked on the streets, cars parked for more than 24 hours and other violations that are detrimental to the residential neighborhoods.
