September 7, 1982

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the seventh day of September, 1982 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

4. After President Weygandt read the agenda for this meeting, council recessed to committees.
5. There was no discussion on the agenda items.

Members of the Department of History and the Gantz House Restoration Committee attended the meeting and questioned the rumor that the council was going to vote for the demolition of the Gantz Farm House. They were assured that the Council had no intention of destroying this structure. Karen Gunderman reported to council an estimated cost of repairs to the house to secure it from weather damage. This appraisal was done by Nitschke Associates, an architectural firm. Mrs. Gunderman stated that the total cost of these repairs would be \$16,000, that the committee has \$6,000 and asked that council consider appropriating the additional \$10,000. Mrs. Gunderman stated that if the city would appropriate some monies and assure the house would be cared for by the city in future years, there were various grants that possibly would be available for the restoration work. The committee was informed that the city could not appropriate \$10,000 in 1982 but would consider it during considerations for the 1983 appropriations. Speaking to this issue were: Donald Cotner, Karen Gunderman, Jane Cotner, Bill Buckley, Randall Sturgeon, and members of the Council and Administration.
7. Council reconvened.
