36 Mayor Haughn announced he has appointed a community fair board of seven (7) members, sole purpose to put on community fair. They are: Larry Crossley, Marcia Self, Jeannette Myers, Dr. Michael Stellar, James O'Connor, Mike Montoney and Harry Monroe. This board will be in power to put on community fair. (NOTE: Council, the mayor cannot create boards or commissions, this has to be done by ordinance).

37 Mayor Haughn advised that he has 5 of the 6 names for the Charter Revision Committee. They are Don Cotner, Thomas Walpole, Stella Feyh, Dr. K. B. Corry and Rev. Paul Meuser. (He is waiting for confirmation on his 6th member).

38 Mr. Harkless asked the mayor if there was anything new regarding the State Fire School using the Marlane area. The mayor advised he was still waiting to hear. He has contacted Mack Pemberton quite often, there is no decision.

Mr. Harkless asked when council will accept the responsibility of re-alignment of wards. He stated this is definitely within the charter. Mr. Yates advised him the 1970 census will establish population. If we did something now the 1970 census could change the picture. Mr. Ozmun advised that it would cause re-alignment of wards if supreme court decision is followed.

39 Mr. Yates advised that council recognized that Mr. Edwards has rendered services to the city at reasonable rate and they wish they could go through and enact this ordinance (C-40-69) however, council has been advised by the state examiner that this constitutes conflict of interest. He further stated that council felt they didn't wish to get involved with something like that. If our attorney would like to get a ruling on this from attorney general, it may be the right move. If this would clear up the thing council was assured there's no real problem of legality, there's no reason why we can't go ahead and pay the bill. The mayor stated that when Mr. Mitchell was here, he had outside help, he didn't do it himself, this isn't anything dif-
