- 22. Council President Norris directed that Ordinance C-56-60-An Ordinance accepting the plat of Grove City Heights an addition and confirming the dedication of the streets and alleys thereon shown be given its second reading. The Clerk read the Ordinance.
- 23. Mr. Martin appeared before Council to suggest a change in the Building Code with reference to requirements for concrete footer construction. Mr. Martin's request was denied by the Council.
- 24. Several residents inquired as to the status of the North-Central Sewer District. They were informed by Council President Norris and the City Engineer that the legislative process had started and the plans had been drawn. Mr. Mitchell, City Engineer, was instructed at this time to amend the plans to include several property owners in the assessment district who had inadvertently been excluded. Mr. Mitchell agreed to take this action.

Mayor Patzer reported that Mr. Howard Sigman, Township Trustee, requested permission from the Council to the Township to install Water Hydrants for fire protection purposes in the Township off of the main water supply line from Columbus. Mr. Thomas submitted a resolution granting such authority to the Council. Mr. Wagner moved to adopt Resolution. Seconded by Mr. Brinkman. A roll call vote was taken.

The Urbancrest Officials were informed that in order to obtain water from the City that they would first have to shown written permission for water from the City of Columbus. Urbancrest would then have to bear the cost of a survey by the Grove City Engineer to determine the feasibility of granting water to the Village. The final step, the Urbancrest Officials were told, would be to present the matter to the Grove City Council for a decision.

28. Mayor Patzer announced that appointment of two Councilmen to the Police Pension Board was in order. Nominations for the Police Pension Board were delcared in order by Council President Norris. Mr. Rothwell nominated Mr. Canter. Mr. Wagner nominated Mr. Norris. The nominations were declared closed. 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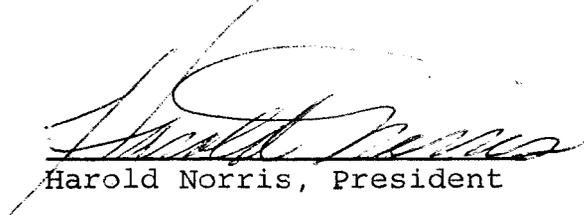
