

## GROVE CITY, OHIO COUNCIL

September 18, 1978

Minutes

Regular Meeting

Before the regular meeting of Council, at 7:00 P.M., the Council, Administration and Tom Willet from the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission met to discuss the Senior Citizens Housing Market Analysis and the Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority. After a lengthy discussion, it was agreed that there is a definite need for subsidized housing for senior citizens in the city and the Council agreed to present a resolution at the next meeting on October 2 to go on record expressing the need for senior housing and to explore the funding possibilities. Council also discussed Resolution No. CR-46-78, Taxicab Rules and Regulations.

17. Mayor Brandt stated that his report on the Mayor's court and Division of Buildings will be given along with this month's report at the next meeting.

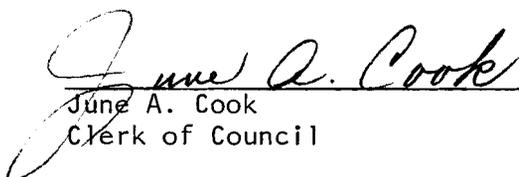
