October 5, 1981

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on October 5, 1981 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

5. A lengthy discussion was held on Ordinance C-57-81 (Appropriation to S/W Jackson Township Civic Association). It was agreed by the council that they financial help the civic association if legally possible. They asked a letter be written to the Township Trustees to join with the city to raise capital for this endeavor to fight the dump.

6. Councilman Douglas expressed his disapproval of the transfer of a D5 liquor permit from Genevieve Kelsy, d/b/a Tack Room Lounge to Genevieve Kelsy, d/b/a Half Moon Saloon, Inc. at 3504 N. Broadway. Mr. Douglas asked that a resolution of objection be drafted for action and that this resolution be forwarded to the Director of Liquor Control.

7. Council reconvened.

8. Ordinance C-56-81 (Amend CATV code) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on October 19.

9. Ordinance C-57-81 (Appro to S/W Jackson Twp. Civic Assoc.) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on October 19.

10. Ordinance C-58-81 (To vacate an alley) was given its first reading. Second reading and public hearing will be on November 16.

11. Resolution CR-39-81 (Objection to Director of Liquor Control) was given its reading and public hearing and Mr. Douglas moved the rules of council be suspended and the waiting period waived; seconded by Mr. Hampson.
