Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Brian Buzby at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

**President Buzby asked that any New Business to be brought before Council, be done so at this time.**


No new business was brought before Council.


**President Buzby recognized the Mayor, members of administration and council for closing comments.**

2. Mr. Behlen noted that several ordinances would be coming their way from his department, one of which would be a request to decrease the millage by .4 mills.
3. Mr. Hamons gave figures from the Ameriflora bus tours. He said it was very successful and as a result \$575.00 will be donated to the DARE Program. He also mentioned that an annexation request for 281 acres (corner of Hoover Rd. and 665) has been filed with the Franklin County Commissioners. This will be the largest annexation since 1975.
5. Mr. Jim Blackburn recognized two of his staff members in attendance this evening.

6. After additional comments from Administration, the Chamber and Council, Mr. Cotton made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Mr. Ferguson. Motion carried.
