

MINUTES OF SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
October 14, 1958

Item:

Meeting called to order by Mayor with all members being present.

Purpose of meeting as explained by the Mayor and requested by the Mayor of the Clerk to give further remarks were as follows:

That the public is not properly informed as to the pros and cons of the proposed chart as prepared by the Charter Commission.

That Council has appropriated the sum of \$920.00 to cover said expenses to place the Charter in the hands of the voters.

That one public meeting only has been held on the Charter, and only a very few people were present.

That to more fully inform the voters and to attract the people to a public meeting where the Articles of Charter could be rebutted or pros and cons presented, that Council should appropriate an additional sum of \$300.00 to defray such expenses.

That to correct the errors of misinterpretations of the purpose of the Charter issue and to have a better informed vote concerning the Charter issue it was proposed that Council had a responsibility in the matter to the voters.

After due consideration and discussion and predicated upon the basis that it could not be determined whether this action would be political or civic and that the State Auditor, due to the lack of law to support his position, would therefore consider it an unauthorized expenditure, the matter was tabled.

No further business to come before the body, the meeting was adjourned.
