October 17, 1977

Regular Meeting

Before the regular meeting of Council, Jim Maguire from the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission discussed the fourth, fifth and sixth year Housing and Community Development program of Franklin County, Ohio and asked the council and the administration to be thinking about how they would like to see the funds for the next three years be used locally.

26. Mr. Walter reported to council about the Ethics Commission Seminar at the Battelle Memorial Institute which he attended.




