1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 19th day of October, 1981 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

2. Mr. Kingsmore moved to dispense the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting; seconded by Mrs. Merriman.

3. President Hampson read the agenda for the meeting and announced the inclusion of Resolution CR-44-81.
4. Council recessed to committees.
5. Speaking to Resolution CR-41-81 was Tom Raney for Bank One.
6. Speaking to Resolution CR-42-81 were Dr. Sheridan and his architect. President Hampson read a letter from Clark and Clark, Attornies at law, stating that Dr. Sheridan would have lots #24 and 25 combined into one tax parcel.
7. Speaking to Resolution CR-44-81 was Bill Shimp, a volunteer for the Franklin County Children Services. Mr. Shimp asked council's support for the 1.6 mill tax levy on the November ballot.
8. John L. Wedge, representing the Grove City Little League and the Pony League read a letter to council requesting the city to consider a long term contract with the leagues for the use of the baseball fields at Windsor Park; that the leagues are willing to invest time and money to the upkeep and improvements of the fields if they are used for baseball only. After a lengthy discussion, President Hampson asked the city attorney to look into the matter of the city contracting public lands to one group. Mr. Kingsmore stated that the matter between the Park Board and the Fair Board is the concern of the Park Board and not the council; that the Park Board has the authority to enforce its own rules and regulations concerning the use of the parks. Steve Carr stated that the Park Board has turned down the Fair Board's request to hold the fair at Windsor Park in 1982.
9. President Hampson read a letter from JoAnn Stevenson, Blodwen Circle, asking council to deny Warner CATV request for increase in rates and to vote no on Ordinance C-56-81.
10. Barbara Birk, representing the Grove City Senior Transportation and Recreation Task force (START) presented the city the keys to the recently acquired Senior Citizen Van.
