2. Reading of minutes of October 6, and on motion to approve same made by Haines, 2nd Hinton, all voted yea.


Minutes of Special Meeting October 14 were suspended with reading, on motion by Haughn, 2nd by Harrington, all voting yea.
3. No report by Mayor.
4. Franklin Ave. no parking area extended on east side of Franklin Ave. from Kunz driveway south beyond driveway of ~~Osborne~~^{HUBBEN}. On motion to approve by Haines, 2nd Haughn, all voted yea.
5. The matter for Public hearing on rezoning Dr. Henry lot on East Park St. was heard and on a motion to approve a variance in the Code to permit the construction of office offered by Hinton, 2nd Harrington, all members voted yea.
6. On a motion by Haines, 2nd Rothwell, the Solicitor was instructed to secure necessary information so as to proceed with a Special Census. All voted yea.
7. Trash Barrels matter referred to Safety and Service Committee for study.
8. In the matter of revising the Building Code, on a motion by Haines, 2nd by Harrington, that a committee of not more than fifteen persons be appointed by Mayor and Council to make necessary study for revision, all members voted yea.
9. Engineer submitted necessary petitions and papers for widening, deepening and improving Republican Run, and on a motion by Haines, 2nd Haughn, that Solicitor draw resolution to authorize Mayor as official to sign said County Ditch Petition, all members voted yea.

On a request from Mr. Brownfield for approval of extending the Sanitary Sewer on Richard Ave. to cover lots 26-27-28-45, on motion to approve same by Hinton, 2nd Harrington, all members voted yea.

On a motion by Haines, 2nd by Kiehl, Council approved the installation of light meters on South Broadway for Christmas lighting, all voted yea.


