Special Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City, Ohio met in special session on October 22, 1979 at 7:30 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

Gerald Kingsmore
Robert Evans
Harold Walter
James Dooley

2. Mr. Dooley introduced and read Resolution CR-46-79, a resolution to support the return of the tennis tournament to the Buckeye Boys Ranch, and he moved it be approved; seconded by Mr. Walter.

3. Mr. McDonald read Ordinance No. C-68-79, an ordinance to amend section 725.01(D) to provide an increase in the rate that may be charged for the collection of garbage and refuse and opened the meeting for discussion.

4. After lengthy discussion of the rates between the council, the mayor, and several interested persons, Mr. Kingsmore moved that Council go into executive session to discuss the rates; seconded by Mr. Dooley.

In executive session, Ordinance No. C-68-79 was discussed and the rate of \$4.00 per month was agreed upon, such rate to be terminated as of December 31, 1979 in order to allow time for formal bidding for an exclusive franchise for picking up garbage and refuse.

5. Council reconvened and Mr. McDonald moved Ordinance C-68-79 be amended in Section 1 to read: Every licensee shall provide pick-up service at intervals not exceeding seven days. The licensee, with the approval of the Director of Public Service, may designate the place and manner in which refuse shall be stored for collection. The licensee shall not charge rates in excess of four dollars (\$4.00) per month per dwelling for residential billing for services rendered. This rate will be terminated as of December 31, 1979. This was seconded by Mr. Kingsmore.




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Council reconvened and Mr. Kingsmore moved Council adjourn; seconded by Mr. Dooley.

October 24, 1979

Special Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in special session on the twenty-fourth day of October, 1979 at 10:00 a.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

James McDonald
Gerald Kingsmore
Robert Evans
Harold Walter
James Dooley

2. President Evans called the meeting to order and explained that the action taken at the special meeting on October 22 was not to the best interest of the citizens because the individual firm that had stated that they would pick up the garbage and refuse for the two month period has reconsidered and will not pick up or bill for only a two month period.

3. In order to discuss the situation and to discuss ways to prevent an emergency situation in the city, Mr. Kingsmore moved that council move to executive session; seconded by Mr. Dooley.

4. In the executive session, Ordinance C-70-79 was discussed as an emergency measure that calls for an emergency contract in lieu of formal bidding. Also it was discussed and decided to put Ordinance C-69-79 on the agenda so that it (new Chapter 725) would state the provisions of the contract.

5. Council reconvened.

6. Ordinance No. C-70-79 was given its reading and Mr. Walter moved it be amended in Section 1 to read: The Director of Public Service, or the Mayor, be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into emergency refuse collection contract with a reputable collection company to provide this service to the citizens of Grove City, Ohio. Such named company in the contract will work under the provisions of Chapter 725 of the Grove City Code of Ordinances.

This was seconded by Mr. Kingsmore.

Mr. McDonald moved that on this ordinance the rules of council be suspended and the waiting period waived; seconded by Mr. Dooley.
