

**GROVE CITY, OHIO COUNCIL
MINUTES**

November 16, 1992

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Brian Buzby at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

President Buzby asked that any New Business to be brought before Council, be done so at this time.

President Buzby recognized Mr. Hamons for a presentation.


Mr. Hamons introduced Mr. Marty Sapperstein, Sapperstein & Associates.


Mr. Sapperstein gave a report on the telephone survey that was conducted for the City. He reviewed the questions that were asked, reported the percentages and gave closing comments. Questions ranged from overall view of Grove City, Quality of Life, Biggest Problems, Fire Department, Administration, Parks & Recreation Department, the need for a Community Pool, if Public Officials are responsive to public needs, how well is the community kept informed by Public Officials, Capital Improvements. In closing, Mr. Sapperstein said he was impressed by the number of people who felt the Quality of Life in Grove City was excellent and that things are better than five years ago.

President Buzby recognized the Mayor, members of administration and council for closing comments.

1. Mayor Stage announced that the Grove City Area Clean Community Photo Index was performed, which essentially means taking pictures of trash in Grove City. He stated that all areas have improved significantly compared to two years ago, however, loading docks still need additional improvement. He also announced a \$49,000 grant from the Governor's Office of Crime & Justice for crime prevention. In addition, the Police Department received an excellent inspection record and a Certificate of Commendation from the Bureau of Detention for our jail cells.
2. Mr. Barry Babbert stated that as a follow up to the telephone survey, a survey was conducted at the Senior Center. Approximately 1000 responses have been received and the department is currently compiling the data.
3. After additional comments from Administration, the Chamber and Council, Mr. Buzby made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Mr. Buckley. Motion carried.
