November 18, 1985

Regular Meeting

1. The Council of the City of Grove City met in regular session on the 18th day of November, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the council chambers with the following members present:

2. Prior to the beginning of the meeting, Kathy Fahy, Vice President of the Grove City Area Chamber of Commerce, presented the council and mayor with the first copies of the Grove City Image Book published by the Chamber as an economical development tool.


Mr. List introduced Mr. Mountain to the public.
