November 26, 2001

Special Meeting

The special meeting of Council was called to order by President Bennett, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Conference Room, City Hall, 4035 Broadway.

**The Chair recognized Mr. Eversman, Chairman of Finance.**

1. Mr. Eversman opened the floor for preliminary review and discussion of the proposed Capital Improvements for the 2002 Appropriation Ordinance.

*Mr. Fulton arrived at 6:40 p.m.*

Mr. Stage, City Administrator, and Mr. Behlen, Director of Finance, provided Council with a Performa and various documentation for certain Capital Projects (YMCA, Traffic Control Improve., Information Hardware), for Council's review and comment. Mr. Behlen pointed out that this puts the City in the same position as estimated in June.

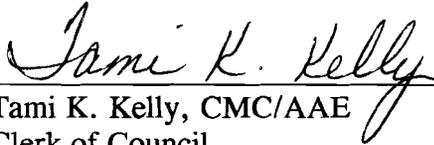
A more detailed discussion took place over the Lumber Yard project, Fryer Park and the YMCA. Council pointed out that during discussions to purchase the Lumber Yard, the Administration said it would not use the property for the Service Department, but wanted it for development toward the Town Center. Mr. Stage said they are looking for potential developers, but doesn't see the risk in using it for our temporary purposes. Questions regarding permanent restrooms for Fryer Park arose. Mr. Stage said they feel that the restrooms at the YMCA & Adventure Play area are more advantageous than the ball diamond area, which is also the most expensive to do.

Mr. Stage shared the Estimated Revenue portion of the Budget.

It was decided to hold a meeting on December 10, 2001 and, if necessary December 13, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. to review the 2002 Budget proposal.

There being no further business to be brought before Council, at this time, the meeting was adjourned by unanimous consent.
