20 Mayor Brandt announced that the hearing on the injunction against the city concerning the downtown parking would be held on December 10 instead of December 2.


21. Mr. Huber announced that he was notified by the Electric Company that they have applied to P.U.C.O. for a 29% increase in electric rates for Grove City.
