18. Mayor Stage thanked Twig #184 of Children's Hospital for the beautiful Christmas decorations as well as the Chamber of Commerce, Grove City High School Band and everyone else who helped make the Christmas weekend downtown such a great success, as well as Helena McComb for the "Tour of Homes".

Mayor Stage announced the hearing of the Community Development Block Grant Program which was held Monday, November 26, 1990. He indicated that there was an excellent turn-out and was thrilled with all the support and interest shown.

Mayor Stage announced the resignation of two members of the Zoning Board of Appeals due to the override of the Ordinance C-89-90. He indicated that he was extremely sorry to lose such qualified people and reiterated his feelings for not wanting this new legislation.

Mayor Stage announced that the City will object to the dissolution of Mayor's Court. Mayor's Court has been coming under fire in many other cities, however, Mayor Stage feels that this is a good practice that should remain in the City of Grove City.


19. Mr. Busby gave a brief explanation and history regarding the override of Ordinance C-89-90 and expressed his reluctance to accept the resignations of two employees of the Zoning Board of Appeals. He also stated that this override was not due to any problems with the Zoning Board but only added an extra appeal for the City.

20. Mr. Nicholson commented on his reasons not to vote for the override of Ordinance C-89-90. He indicated that he agreed and supported the legislation but due to testimony given by the members of the Zoning Board of Appeals, thought it would be better to allow the veto to stand.


